
2022 Site Speed Standard Benchmark Summary


Did you know that if a page takes longer than 4 seconds to load, over 60% of shoppers will bounce?




Slow page load times can drastically reduce conversion rates. More than 60% of shoppers will leave a site in frustration if page load times exceed the 4 second mark. Conversely, conversion rates are the highest on sites where pages load in 3 seconds or less.



Did you know that the deepest shopper sessions on an eCommerce site have the fastest page load times?



Shoppers stay longer on faster sites. These deeper shopper sessions allow brands to build better relationships with shoppers and ultimately show them more products. This can be a big boost to revenue streams.



The conversion zone is the point in time when the share of converted sessions outpaces the share of sessions. These conversion zone moments happen when pages load in under 4 seconds, where lots of sessions – and even more conversions - happen.
